Airports:

CTAF frequencies can become very busy especially when an instrument approach procedure is associated with an airport. Use the correct frequency. Keep transmissions brief and on target so all users can communicate for safety. Also remember that not all may know the names and locations of various points on the IAP. Use distance and direction in your calls to communicate with those who may not have instrument training or are not familiar with the procedure.

Airspace:

We all recognize that the number and availability of approaches, especially precision approaches, are limited throughout Arizona. You are encouraged to use appropriate options to expand in the air training options ie. Luke Aux 1 ILS, intersection holds, etc. Use simulators where and when you are able.

Parachute operations have been noted in the vicinity of Hidden Valley Airport southwest of E68 and south of HWY 238.

Operations and Processes:

The NTSB and FAA report key accident causes are Loss of control, weather, and owner maintenance. Train to avoid these problems.

Other:

Recall that after the New Year and into Feb traffic volume and restrictions will be increased due to the Pro Bowl, Golf Tournaments, Super Bowl and Auto Auctions. The preliminary notice of the TFR is out and posted on the AFTW Web site as well as other locations.
