Airspace

- Discussed CGZ stack
 - Brief description of TDF VOR for those not familiar
 - Reiterated to state “time” not distance from the stack
- Practice Area Chart
- NE Practice Area Reporting points
 - Discussion on breaking down the area into more specific reporting points
 - Ex: North of Dynamite Road
 - West of Rio Verde Community is a large area, divide into sections
- Aerobatic box near Santan Mountains no longer operational? – Any confirmation?
- SW Practice area – would be nice to make some reporting points and section that area
- Creating a kneeboard size version of the practice area chart for ease of use
 - Can load PDF into documents in ForeFlight
 - OpenAir program – can define airspace and draw on chart for EFB

Airports

- KBXK closed 12 to 22 Sept and 5-6 Oct
- E63 has self-serve fuel, least expensive, look out for increased traffic
- KIWA – North ramp phased yearlong construction project starting Oct/Nov
 - Landing fee at KIWA now
 - New restaurant/micro-brewery opening end of Oct
- KFFZ – Construction of blast pads on north runway and taxiway C to begin in Nov
 - Cooperstate Oct 28-29
 - 1500’ foot rule, 2-3 aircraft possible on same runway like Oshkosh. Will be issued “land short” or “land long”
 - Camping on field
 - Organization meeting beginning of October
- KPRC – AOPA fly in and ERAU homecoming airshow Sept 30 – Oct 1
 - 500+ aircraft expected
